ALL SHOW CATTLE MUST BE HALTER LED. ALL BULLS <u>MUST</u> BE HALTER LED AND HAVE NOSE RINGS WITH NOSE ROPES (EXCEPT DISPERSALS AND REDUCTIONS)

ALL SHOW ANIMALS <u>MUST</u> BE INDICATED ON THE ENTRY FORM AND NO OTHERS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE SHOW. UNLED FEMALES WILL BE SOLD AT THE END OF THE LED FEMALES

ALL STOCK HANDLERS **MUST** WEAR WHITE COATS IN THE SALE AND SHOW RING

CATTLE FROM DISPERSAL SALES ARE PERMITTED IN THE SHOW, THEY MUST BE ENTERED FOR THE SHOW ON THE ENTRY FORM, THESE ANIMALS WOULD THEN BE **SOLD IN THE MAIN SALE.**

BVD INFORMATION

Females must have completed a full course of BVD vaccination prior to being served and if not from an accredited herd they must have blood tested antigen negative. Bulls must have completed a full course of BVD vaccination and if not from an accredited herd they must have tested antigen negative.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Any females sold as in-calf <u>must</u> be accompanied by a valid P.D certificate which will be given to the auctioneers either with the entry form or the passport prior to the sale. This will be checked by the stewards.

Females sold as A.I'd should be accompanied by a service certificate. The service sire and dates must be stated on the entry form for females sold as running with the bull

Any animals not conforming to the standards laid down by the society will be re-classified and sold in the appropriate section of the sale.

Any vendor declaring the health status of their animals must provide the Society with a signed declaration and a copy of their health certificate where appropriate.

The society will process the transfers following the sale. Please note vendors are now responsible for the payment of transfer fees and therefore this shall be deducted from the vendor's cheque at the time of sale. (Transfer fee £12 including VAT)

T.B. TESTING

Please note that in line with Scottish Government legislation, all animals entered from a TB1 or TB2 area will require a pre-movement TB test within 30 days prior to the movement to Scotland. This also applies to any animal that has been in a TB1 or TB2 area (ie gone to a show) since the 18th May 2024. Post movement requirements are still between 60 and 120 days.

Buyers have approached the Society to request that we ask vendors to TB test their entries within 30 days prior to the sale as this would give buyers confidence to buy. As a Society we would like to strongly recommend that vendors voluntary TB test their entries for the sale and state this on the form at time of entry as we feel this would encourage and give confidence to buyers.

SEMEN TESTING

Buyers have approached the Society to request that we ask vendors to Semen test any bulls prior to the sale and state this on the form so that it can be included in the catalogue, and this would give confidence to both the buyer and the vendor.

BLUE TONGUE

Please make yourself aware of what requirements are needed regarding bluetongue by speaking with your vet and referring to the government websites

Vaccination may be required and, if so, must be done fully to comply before any movement

ENTRIES

- ENTRY FORMS AND PEDIGREE CERTIFICATES (WITH EXCEPTION OF STORE CATTLE) MUST BE SENT ALONG WITH £50 INCLUSIVE OF VAT PER ANIMAL PAYABLE TO THE BGCS. (£35 inclusive of VAT, refunded on presentation of animal, veterinary certificate or at the discretion of council)
