3. **Led Cow -** *to be born on or before 23/05/22*
4. **Bulls -** *(entries will be divided into senior & junior sections after entries have closed).*
5. **Unled Female**
6. **Appendix Female**
7. **Dispersals**
8. **White Galloways**

All animals **MUST** be entered and registered in the herd book of the Belted Galloway Cattle Society and is open to all Members of the Society

**ALL PEDIGREE ENTRIES ARE SUBJECT OF AN ENTRY FEE OF £20 (incl VAT) PER ANIMAL WHICH MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRY FORMS.**

All Stock Handlers **must** wear a white show coat in the show & sale ring.

**Cattle from Dispersal Sales** these animals will be sold within the Dispersal section of the sale catalogue.

**BVD Information** – All Entries **MUST** be vaccinated against BVD (Bovine Viral Diarrhoea).

Please see separate information enclosed regarding Society ruling for BVD testing and vaccination for registered cattle included into the sale.

**Herd Health Declaration** – Please complete the attached herd health declaration and return with all entries.

The Belted Galloway Cattle Society reserves the right to contact the CHECS scheme of which you are a member to check the accuracy of the information provided.

**Inspection** – A Breed Inspection for all females will take place from 7am on morning of the sale. Any animals not conforming to the standards laid down by the society will be re-classified and sold in the appropriate section of the sale.

**Service Details** – Any females sold as in-calf **must** be accompanied by a valid P.D. certificate which will be given to the auctioneers either with the entry form or the passport prior to the sale. This will be checked by the stewards.

Females sold as AI'd should be accompanied by a service certificate.

The service sire and dates must be stated on the entry form for females sold as running with the bull.

**Conditions of Sale** – The Sale is held under the General Conditions of Sale & Special Conditions, approved by the Council of the Belted Galloway Cattle Society. Any disputes arising shall be solely the responsibility of the vendor and purchaser. The Belted Galloway Society shall not be responsible in any form.

**Method of Sale:** All cattle will be sold in guineas (105 pence) and strictly in catalogue order, unless any alteration is announced by the Auctioneers.

**Transfer of Ownership:** All transfer fees are payable by the vendor, which is £10 + VAT.

**TB PRE-MOVEMENT TESTING - TB pre-movement testing is a mandatory requirement for all cattle over the age of 41 days moving out of 1 year tested herds must be pre-movement tested within 60 days prior to sale.**
